## CentOS Linux 8 Support Plans: March 2022

As announced in December 2020 by the Red Hat Inc. CentOS Project, development of the Community Enterprise Operating System (CentOS Linux 8) ended December 31, 2021.

Consequently, the last ANSYS Inc. release to support CentOS 8.1, 8.2, and 8.3 will be release 2022 R2 in July 2022. Previously, support of versions 8.1, 8.2, and 8.3 was planned for release 2023 R1 and 2023 R2.

There are no plans at this time to support CentOS Stream.

ANSYS Inc. will begin supporting the Ubuntu Linux operating system/distribution with release 2022 R2 in July 2022.
